Are you tired of hand sewing quilt sleeves to the back of your wall quilts? Or do you resort to purchase "hanging" kits as you just cannot deal with all the time it takes to sew one on? This class is your answer!

You will learn how easy it is to sew an entire sleeve onto any size quilt all by machine! We will measure & cut fabric needed for a small quilt project, prepare it for sewing to the quilt, then sew the entire sleeve on by machine! NO hand sewing.

Skills you will take away:

- How to measure and cut your sleeve strip for any size quilt.
- How to pin and sew to the top of the quilt and then how to attach the bottom section of the sleeve. How to add "give" to the back of sleeve if you are entering into a quilt competition

## Supplies for class:

Fabric: small finished quilt for attaching sleeve OR a pre-quilted quilt sandwich with a binding attached. Size should be at least 18" long on one side for sleeve attachment.

Scissors, thread, machine needle, straight pins, a seam ripper & a 6" metal dressmakers ruler with slide.
