# Continuous Bias Bindings



Learn my foolproof method for making continuous BIAS binding.

Have you avoided those beautiful quilts with curved edges because it requires BIAS Binding? Does just the thought of cutting strips on a 45° angle to make bias binding make you want to forget that quilt? Take this class and you will wonder why it was ever such a big issue.

Whether you cut your fabric manually with a rotary cutter or use an AccuQuilt strip cutter you will see how simple it really is to make bias.

You will Learn the traditional method of manually cutting your strips starting with a square piece of fabric, then cutting, resewing, marking and finally cutting your strip in one continuous strip. We will then use a strip cutter to do the same with but without having to mark or manually cut the actual fabric.

I will demonstrate how to sew the continuous bias binding to a curved border quilt so you can try it when you get home !

Includes detailed printed instructions and a size chart for making various lengths of bias binding.

Supplies for class: Cotton Fabric: 2—20" X 20" Pieces , each should be a different color, pressed and ready to cut. Plus standard sewing supplies (scissors, cotton thread, machine needles, seam ripper, straight pins, marking pencils that contrast with your fabric, 18" or longer ruler)
